## Objectives

# Objective 1 &2: Attain and maintain HIV epidemic control among at-risk adult men, women and PPs and KPs

# Support group meeting:

AMDA EpiC Nepal conducted support group meeting on 24<sup>th</sup> ,28<sup>th</sup> & 29<sup>th</sup> October 2021 in Morang, Jhapa & Sunsari District respectively. A total of 35 PLHIV (13 Male and 22 Female) participated in the meeting, maintaining all the precautions including proper distancing and proper use of mask. Meeting was facilitated by Case manager and PN. Discussion was done on Importance of ARV medicine, Adherence to treatment, U=U, ART enrollment and re enrollment of all positive cases, 180 days packages, importance of Index based partner testing and also regarding the Merosathi booking link for various services.

## Monthly review meeting:

AMDA EpiC Nepal conducted monthly review meetings to review the progress and decide way forward on 27<sup>th</sup> October in Jhapa, Morang and Sunsari district. In the meeting there was presence of PC, AFO, M&E Officer, HA, CBS, PN and Lab staffs. There was discussion on following:

- District and indicators wise target vs achievement.
- Gaps in case findings, ART enrollment, viral load testing, PrEP initiation.
- Known positive mapping for known positive listing & follow ups.
- Safety & security of all beneficiaries & all staffs from COVID-19 Pandemic.
- Follow up of IIT clients for ART re-enrollment.
- Focus of 3 campaigns ART enrollment, re-enrollment and viral load testing.

#### **Online Activities**

- A total of 2 FSWs and 16 Clients of FSWs was reached through online platform for HIV testing, STI, PrEP & Covid-19 prevention in Jhapa.
- Also 2 FSWs were followed through phone for HIV testing, STI, PrEP and COVID-19 prevention in Jhapa.
- A total of 4 FSWs and 19 PPs were reached through online platform for HIV testing, STI, PrEP & Covid-19 prevention in Sunsari.
- Also 40 FSWs and 4 PP was followed through phone for HIV testing, STI, PrEP and COVID-19 prevention in Sunsari.
- A total of 2 PPs and 3 PPs were reached through online platform for HIV testing, STI, PrEP & Covid-19 prevention in Morang.
- Also 16 FSWs were followed through phone for HIV testing, STI, PrEP and COVID-19 prevention in Morang.
- Also 32 PLHIV (20 male, 11 female and 1 other) were followed through phone for ART adherence, index partner testing, viral load testing and other services in Jhapa.
- Also PLHIV (16 male & 30 female) were followed through phone for ART adherence, index partner testing, viral load testing and other services in Sunsari.

• A total of 2 Merosathi bookings were made 1/1 Jhapa and Sunsari for October & HIV testing of done at Sunsari & result was non-reactive.

# **ARV Distribution Services**

- In this period 10 PLHIV were supported for pill pick up from ART center in community and home by PN and CBS in Jhapa district.
- In this period 14 PLHIV were supported for pill pick up from ART center in community and home by PN and CBS in Sunsari district.

- Participated in the coordination meeting with development partners on 22<sup>nd</sup> Oct.2021 for National Condom Day Celebration 2078.

# Viral Load campaign

• In this period Viral load sample collection was done in coordination with BDS Sub IPs, ART Center and CCCs. During this period, a total of 21 samples in Jhapa, 6 samples in Sunsari and 4 samples in Morang districts were collected and sent to Koshi Zonal Hospital.

# Day Celebration

27<sup>th</sup> National Condom Day was celebrated in Jhapa, Morang, Sunsari and Illam district in coordination with Local government and other stakeholders with maintain preventive measures of COVID-19.

#### Jhapa:

- Informative message on importance and uses of condom was disseminated through audio clip.
- Also, Information stall was kept at Muktichowk area with IEC materials; condom promotion, distribution and demonstration. Almost 29 people participated in the stall and gained the information and knowledge.
- Total 1600 pieces of condom were distributed.
- Candle lighting in memory of those who lost their lives due to HIV/STI was done in the middle of Muktichowk in support of Traffic Police.

## Illam:

- Play card preparation and exhibition through rally from Tudikhel to Illam Chowk Bazar. Informative messages and importance of proper condom use disseminated through the play cards.
- Total 1500 pieces of condom were distributed.
- Finally, candle lighting was done in the middle of Illam Chowk Bazar.

## Sunsari:

- Rally on city rickshaw with IEC materials and Informative message on importance and uses of condom was disseminated through audio clip around Itahari Sub Metropolitan City.
- IEC materials; condom promotion, distribution and demonstration was done during the event.
- Total 15000 pieces of condom were distributed during nagar parikrama in major hotspots to FSWs, Clients and Hotel Owner

# Morang:

- Informative message on importance and uses of condom was disseminated through audio clip.
- Also, Information stall was kept at Rani boarder area with IEC materials; condom promotion, distribution and demonstration.
- Total 21000 pieces of condom were distributed.

- Motivational Counseling training to newly appointed CBS was given by SI unit from 25<sup>th</sup> to 28<sup>th</sup> October 2021 in Ktm.
- Clinical orientation to case managers was given by TU from 25-28<sup>th</sup> October in Ktm.
- Virtual Orientation to Laboratory staffs on HIV testing, HIV viral load, EID, recency testing, quality assurance and basic laboratory management was given by TU on 28<sup>th</sup> October.

#### **Monthly ART center Meetings**

#### Morang

In this period monthly ART meeting was done on 29<sup>th</sup> October 2021 at Koshi ART center. In the meeting there was presence of Mesu. Dr.Chuman Lal Das, ART Doctor Dr. Hari Khanal, Chief Administrator Nabaraj Luitel, Lab Incharge Pranab Kumar Yadav, Lalit Chaudhary, ART counselor Ms. Laxmi Gautam, OPD Incharge Laxmi Thapa, HA ART, Case Manager of PSS, AMDA PC, Field Supervisor, Peer Navigator. There was discussion on the free OPD card ticketing of all PLHIV in easy ways. In this agenda Mesu suggested to give extra 1 hour for OPD ticketing of all PLHIV during viral load testing for OPD Incharge.

ART counselor requested to provide separate room for counseling for PLHIV clients, In this agenda Mesu suggested its not possible to provide separate room now but will address in coming days when new building will completed which is in construction.

#### Sunsari

In this period monthly meeting with Inaruwa Hospital, ART center was done in the presence of acting. Mesu Of Inaruwa Hospital, Lab staffs, Administration Staffs, OPD staffs, ART counselor, M&E

officer, HA ART of AMDA Nepal on 31<sup>st</sup> October 2021. The discussion was made on new case finding (Offer index testing), ART enrollment of known positive, Viral load testing, IIT tracing & reenrollment and PrEP Importance.
