1. Number of sites. Are all sites have separate or single PAN number?

Query: It is stated that there are five sites. How many hospitals? Hospital bed capacity. Clarity:

- a. 100 beded Siddhartha Children and Women Hospital, Butwal, Rupandehi
- b. 100 beded AMDA Hospital Damak, Jhapa
- c. 15 beded AMDA Mechi Hospital, Mechinagar, Jhapa
- d. Dental clinic with one chair, Gokarneshwar, Kathmandu

AMDA Nepal uses only one PAN number for all sites.

2. Hardware Requirement

Query: Local Server

Clarity: AMDA Nepal will provide the production servers for its all sites.

3. Centralized Database and Synchronization

**Query**: (C. XVII.) System should run in IP network which is setup locally and/or remotely for centralized server.

Clarity: The software is need to be designed to operate on the local servers of individual hospitals or clinics. It should allows for synchronization of the database from various branches, creating a centralized database. This centralized database should serves as the source for generating individual branch reports as well as compiled reports. The database synchronization should occurs in customized frequency (eg Two every 24 hours.

4. Database Configure

**Query**: (C. VIII) Capability to configure with another database (PostgreSQL, MySQL, MariaDB, SQL Server, Oracle etc.)

Clarity: The software should have the capability to be configured to work with different types of databases, including PostgreSQL, MySQL, MariaDB, SQL Server, Oracle. By supporting multiple databases, the system offers flexibility and compatibility with a wide range of database platforms.



This flexibility is valuable in situations where the database currently in use requires the purchase of a license. In such cases, the software can be configured to seamlessly transition to an open-source database or a licensed database for which the organization already holds a valid license.
