Objective of the activity:

- To disseminate and bring awareness among President community women regarding imperative aspect of breast & cervical cancer screening services.
- To bring awareness regarding breast and cervical cancer to all the women of that specific group through president.
- To be accessible to all the women of Gokarneshwor Municipality to nearby health facility and AMDA Clinic.

Activity details

Total 6 educational event was conducted among President, Vice President and Secretary of Aama and Mahila Samuha of ward 1,2,3,4,5 and 9 on 8, 22,24,27 & 28 November 2023 which was conducted at the respective ward office. The program was conducted in the presence of Ward President, Focal Person of Health Department of Gokarneshwor Municipality(GM) and the facilitator from GM. Before the commencement of the program, Ward President highlighted the main objective of the program and the reason for the selection of only President, Vice President and Secretary of Aama and Mahila Samuha of the respective ward in order to disseminate the awareness regarding breast and cervical cancer to all the women of that specific group through president and also increase the accessibility to all the women of Gokarneshwor Municipality to nearby health facility and AMDA Clinic.

Likewise, Ms. Srijana Shrestha, Program Officer, AMDA Nepal addressed the importance of early diagnosis and treatment of the services, also emphasized on utmost importance to receive the service by all the women as this need to be continued in every 3 years till the age of 60 years as early diagnosis helps to cure the disease through simple procedures and highlighted on screening service which should be done by the healthy women rather than by ill person. Additionally, she also stated on the service available at all the health facility and AMDA clinic.

Further, Ms. Shobha Shrestha, Facilitator, GM started the session. She presented on Breast and Cervical Cancer, its causes, diagnosis, sign and symptoms, prevention and treatment and services provided during screening camp and health facilities, benefits of the service and its importance of early detection. Also emphasized the imperative aspects of screening on healthy person and tried to bring positive change in their health seeking behaviors of women instead of being shy and hesitated through sharing the examples we had experienced during camp. Addressed the few queries they had regarding the Breast and Cervical cancer and gynae problems they had. Also emphasized on the breast diagnostic screening camp that need to done at AMDA clinic for USG and Mammogram services after clinical examination. And importance of regular screening of both services after 3-year interval till the client reaches up to 60 years old at nearby health facilities.

She also emphasized to be aware first and also to bring awareness among family members and all the women of respective group by sharing the information she has understood in this educational activity.

The program was officially closed with the closing remarks by Mr. Hari Prasad Upadhaya, PHO, GM with the highlight of the program including the utmost important aspects and also, addressed that it is a great way to raise awareness about breast & cervical cancer and disseminate the information to all the women through participation of President, Vice President and Secretary of Aama and Mahila Samuha.

Participants feedback/ suggestions/ opinions: Participants were feeling grateful for such informative session and also expressed about their health seeking behavior. Most of them were unware about the screening service they can receive from nearby health facility and about the camp as well. Also, they had a trust issue for the service they receive from health facility which was cleared with the assurance and details on services from health center and they agreed to receive the service and will

visit AMDA clinic for diagnostic service on a scheduled day.
