B. Narrative Summary of Activities and Key Findings

1. Details on Screening Camp

The activities undertaken in the camp have been listed in the points below in a sequential manner.

- Registration of clients was undertaken.
- Written informed consent was taken from the clients in the consent form.
- Breast and Cervical Cancer Screening Forms were filled which included personal details, medical history, family history and detail on procedure conducted and findings.
- Blood pressure and height of the clients were measured and recorded.
- Cervical cancer screening was performed through visual inspection of the cervix with acetic acid (VIA).
- After the cervical cancer screening, clinical examination of breast was performed for breast cancer screening.

- The findings from both the cervical and breast cancer screening was disseminated by the medical team with necessary health information and counseling.
- Those women who were screened positive (VIA positive) in the screening tests were referred to the Teaching Hospital for confirmatory diagnosis and prompt treatment.

The event was targeted to women between 30 to 60 years of age. A total of 61 women attended the camp

and among them 60 clients benefitted from cervical cancer screening services and 61 clients benefited from breast cancer screening service.

4. Training to Health Facility Staffs

We had trained total 7 staffs of different health facility of Gokarneshwore Municipality and 1 Program Officer from AMDA, which was conducted from 28th to 31stth December 2021 at Mariestopes Training Center, Satdobato. For intial 3 days, staffs were trained on VIA for Cervical Cancer Screening and 1 day for Breast Cancer Screening. All staffs were satisfied with the training and eager to implement the knowledge and provide the service through their health facility to women.

7. Lesson Learned

To bring change in health seeking behavior in women was quite challenging. Awareness should be disseminated by the leader they rely most and must be done with the frequent door-to-door visit. Also, the friend, neighbor, family and husband perception regarding the same does impact on the women decision for their health seeking behavior.

8. Success Story



Rupa Dangi, 48 years old, women is one of our satisfied client who visited to receive the screening service of both breast and cervical cancer at AMDA Clinic on 4th December 2021.

By profession she is beautician, had a beauty salon and also a women leader in her community who is actively engaged in several womens group. During programs or any community related work, she directly comes in contact with women where they communicate not only work related activities but also share their personal problems. As always, she helps to those women to solve their problem and also counsel if there are any health related issues to them.

Actually, she came to AMDA clinic to receive the Dental Service.

While visiting, she saw the banner regarding Breast and Cervical Cancer Screening services which

was displayed outside the office and the same in the notice board. This made her queries as she was planning to go for the gynae and breast check-up in Teaching Hospital. She had some baggy mass under both arms, had a family history of breast cancer and would like screen if there are any gynae problems that may be because of her age factor. So, while waiting for dental services, we provided the details information on screening camp we are conducting in AMDA clinic. Also, provided the information on importance of screening for the breast and cervical cancer by using both brochures. She was very glad to know the services she was planning to receive was nearby her home. So, she was eager to receive the service and also, requested for the few brochures so that she can disseminate the details to her contact women through her beauty salon and also through the programs she attend.

On 4th December, she visited along with **10 more** women of her community to receive the service. Everyone received the service in their turn. Regarding baggy mass under her both arm, that was diagnosed as a fatty tissue which can be removed through surgery and VIA test was negative and had no any gynae problems i.e infection etc. She was so contented to receive both services and be certain on health status of both breast and cervix as these both part are highly prone to cancer and disease with the age of women and showed gratitude on providing services to nearby their locality to all the women. Also, requested to inform her the date of screening service at AMDA clinic so that she can refer the women she is in contact with.
