2. KEY ACHIEVEMENTS

- Attended Annual Review Meeting of Gokarneshwor Municipality(GM) on 13 August 2023 at meeting hall of GM in the presence of total 30 number of participants of health department and different 4 stakeholder of Gokarneshwor Municipality.
- Among total trained 22 FCHVs on Kobo Tool,13 FCHV had done the door to door visit by using Kobo tool on August 2023.
- We had conducted three **educational activities** among Tarebhir Sawastha Aama Samuha at Tarebhir Urban Health Center, Musare Tol Swastha Aama Samuha at Musure Tol, Tarebhir, ward 3 and Aarubari Mahila Samuha at Gram Nirman Bandu Mandal Club, ward 9 on 4 and 23 August 2023.
- 3 events of one-day free breast & cervical cancer screening camp were conducted at AMDA Clinic, Ward 6, Ghyam Gumba, Nayapati 2 and Jorpati Health Post, Ward 9 on 12, 19 and 26 August 2023 respectively. A total of 199 women attended the camp and among them 199 clients benefited from breast cancer screening service (BCSS) and 185 clients benefitted from cervical cancer screening services (CCSS) and. Out of them, 31 women found with Benign Lump and 2 clients with VIA positive.
- **Diagnostic screening camp** were conducted at AMDA Clinic. A total of 208 clients benefited with the service, where 82 client received the USG service, 120 clients received the Mammogram service and 6 clients received Colposcopy Service on 1,12,22,29, and 30 August 2023. We had disseminated the reports of mammogram to all the clients.
- Among total 10 **health facilities**, 8 health facilities have provided the breast and cervical cancer screening services to 49 clients at respective health facility in this month.

The program was commenced with the warm welcome speech by Hari Prasad Upadhaya, Public Health Officer, Gokarneshwor Municipality. The evaluation committee was formed for the evaluation on the presentation of respective health facilities. After that, along with the health post, 4 different stakeholders were requested to share the progress report of the respective program from Jan 2021 to June 2023.

Here, we got an opportunity to share the presentation about the program from January 2021 to June 2023. We shared all the progress reports in respective activities we had accomplished with the key achievements, training to health service provider, follow up session, referral services and the positive impact on women health among community people through this program.

Further, all the other stakeholder and health facility in charge shared the progress report they had in their respective health facilities.

At the end of the program, closing remarks was given by Nawaraj Bagale, PHI, Gokarneshwor Municipality, with his valuable suggestion and appreciation regarding the program and also, highlighted on imperative aspects of all the program conducted through different health facilities to community people.

Among total trained 23 FCHVs on Kobo Tool, only 13 FCHVs had done the door to door visit by using **Kobo tool** on August 2023. Total 200 clients had been visited by FCHV, among all 54 were old followed up clients and 146 clients were new clients to whom they referred for the service. Also, visited 2 FCHVs for reinstallation of the software and also ensured if there was any problem during door to door activities. Followed up 5 FCHVs to continue the door to door activities and to identify the reason for not continuing.

Activity details

Three educational events were conducted at Tarebhir Urban Health Center, Musure Tol, Tarebhir, Ward 3 and Gram Nirman Bandu Mandal Club, Ward 9 among Ananda Nagari Swargadwari Mahila Samuha, Musare Tol Swastha Aama Samuha and Aarubari Mahila Samuha where 106 women participated from Samuha on 4 and 23 August 2023.

During donor visit, FCHV of Tarebhir has informed regarding client perception about cancer screening service and the need of awareness activity. So, based on it and before the commencement of service from Tarebhir Urban Health clinic, we planned to conduct educational activities at two different groups at two different sites and our main objective along with awareness program was to advise the clients to receive the service from their nearby health facility. After this educational activity, the service has commenced from the health facility.

We aware about various aspects of Breast and Cervical Cancer Screening Services and its importance of early detection. Also emphasized the imperative aspects of screening on healthy person and tried to bring positive change in their health seeking behaviors of women instead of being shy and hesitated. Addressed the few queries they had regarding the Breast and Cervical cancer and gynae problems they had. Also, emphasized to receive the service from their nearby health facility as well.

We also accentuated on the breast diagnostic screening camp that need to done at AMDA clinic for USG and Mammogram services after clinical examination. And importance of regular screening of both services after 3-year interval till the client reaches up to 60 years old at nearby health facilities.

• Participants feedback/ suggestions/ opinions:

Participants were feeling grateful for such informative session and also expressed about their health seeking behavior. As this session had changed the view on screening services and need of regular checkup for the optimum health of their own instead of going hospital after being ill. Also, all women assured that they will go to receive the service on schedule day as well at their nearby health facilities.

Activity details

3 events of one-day free breast & cervical cancer screening camp were conducted at AMDA Clinic, Ward 6, Gyam Gumba, Nayapati, Ward 2 and Jorpati Health Post, Arubari, Ward 9 on 12,19, and 26 August 2023 respectively. A total of 199 women attended the camp and among them 199 clients benefitted from breast cancer screening service (BCSS) and 185 clients benefitted from cervical cancer screening services (CCSS). Out of them, 31 women found with Benign Lump in the breast. Likewise, 2 clients were diagnosed with VIA positive. Furthermore, there were 19 clients with previous history of Breast Cancer Screening. However, 57 clients had previous history of Cervical Cancer Screening. Meanwhile, we had provided diagnostic screening services at AMDA clinic on USG and Mammogram services. Among all 31 Benign clients, total 22 client received the diagnostic screening services and remaining 8 clients didn't visit for the service. Furthermore, we will follow up, 2 VIA positive clients, for Colposcopy service on 30 August 2023.
