Objectives:

1. To disseminate the key achievement, progress and update of the program from Jan to March 2023 to Gokarneshwor Municipality.
2. To conduct screening camp at AMDA Clinic, Ward 6.

Achievements:

1. The both programs was conducted smoothly in a planned way.
2. There were total 37 participants in the Quarter Review Meeting program conducted at BBC hotel, Chisapani, Kathmandu on April 28 2023. During meeting, program officer presented the program objective, activities, progress report, service report, achievement, budget, lesson learned and challenges faced during this first quarter of year third and highlighted the support required by health team to navigate the program smoothly. Also, shared the program plan of 2nd quarter along with the set targets. Addressed the participant's queries on the program and also, focused on the strengthening of the service delivery from the health facilities.
3. Breast and cervical cancer screening camp conducted at AMDA clinic on April 29 2023. During camp, total number of registration was 46, Breast cancer screening service received by 46 clients and 7 clients identified with Benign Lump. Likewise, 42 clients received the cervical cancer screening services among which 2 clients identified with VIA positive. Among two, one client, cervical biopsy was taken and proceeded for the referral services and the other client was advised for the colposcopy services on next camp schedule at AMDA Clinic. All the clients received the screening services including diagnostic screening services based on a single visit approach.
4. During USG screening services, 3 clients were identified with lymphadenopathy in right, left and bilateral breast respectively and one client with hypoechoic lesion at left breast. Advised for follow up after one year.
