Objectives:

Objective 1: Increased access to and demand for HIV services that reduce HIV incidence and improve health and lives of PLHIV.

Support group meeting:

Jhapa:

AMDA-USAID Sustainable HIV Epidemic Control conducted support group meeting on 20th December, 2024 in Birtamod Field Office, Jhapa. A total of 13 PLHIV (7 female, 6 male) participated in the meeting. Meeting was facilitated by Case Manager, CBS & PN. Discussion was done on Health Insurance, U=U, ART enrollment and re enrollment of all positive cases, importance of Index based partner testing and about viral load.

Sunsari

AMDA-USAID Sustainable HIV Epidemic Control conducted support group meeting on 9th December 2024 in Itahari Field Office, Sunsari. A total of 12 PLHIV (11 Female and 1 Male) participated in the meeting. Meeting was facilitated by Case manager and PN. Discussion was done on Health Insurance, U=U, ART enrollment and re enrollment of all positive cases, importance of Index based partner testing and about viral load.

Monthly review meeting:

- MRM of Morang was conducted on 22nd of December at Biratnagar Field office where performance of all the staffs was discussed regarding their contribution in achievement of the milestone.
- MRM of Jhapa was conducted on 23rd of December at Birtamod city clinic office where performance of all the staffs was discussed regarding their contribution in achievement of the milestone. Also, we planned for preparation of SIMS visit.

Online Activities:

- In this reporting period 75 people booked for service through online of which 67 of them arrived to receive the service in Sunsari city clinic.
- In this reporting period 3 people booked for service through online and 3 arrived to receive the service in Birtamod city clinic.

Creative events:

• Morang

Conducted creative event (PrEP focused) on 24th December, 2024 in Biratnagar Field Office. A total of 15 FSWs (1.2=4, 1.3=8.67=3) participated in the event facilitated by CBS, PN and Case Manager. The discussion was mainly focused on importance of PrEP and its continuation for safety from HIV AIDS. Along with that HIV related preventive measures were also discussed in the meeting.

• Jhapa

Conducted creative event (PrEP focused) on 16th December in Birtamod City clinic. A total of 11 FSWs (1.2-5, 1.3-6) were participated in the event which was facilitated by HA, DIC, CBS & P.N. Discussion was done about the importance of PrEP its advantages, sexually transmitted Infections (STIs) and its effects. In this event, 10 KP tested for HIV & STI and 4 KP started PrEP, 1 KP restarted PrEP, 3 KP refill Also 6 KPs was diagnosed and 4 treated for Sexually Transmitted Infections (STIs).

Stigma and Discrimination Reduction Training:

Viral Load campaign

- In Morang district total of 16 viral load sample collection was done on December , 2024in coordination with ART Center and BDS sub-IPs and send to NPHL
- In Sunsari a total of 65 viral load sample collection was done on November in coordination with ART Center and BDS sub-IPs and send to NPHL
- In Jhapa a total of 43 viral load sample collection was done on November in coordination with ART Center and BDS sub-IPs and send to NPHL and 21 Viral Load result received.
- In Ilam a total of 13 viral load sample collection was done on November in coordination with ART Center and send to NPHL and 13 Viral Load result received.

They monitored the process of service delivery from Itahari clinic along with interaction with field staffs for issues and challenges are they facing in case detection, ART enrollment & ART adherence, viral load testing, CD4 Testing.

Inception Meeting

• The Provincial Inception meeting was organized on December 2nd, 2024 at Hotel Eastern Star, Biratnagar by AMDA Nepal in the presence of governmental and non-governmental stakeholders (Health Secretary, Director of Koshi Province Health Directorate, Director of Koshi Province Public Health laboratory, NCASC representative, Chief of PHLM, Mesu and representative of Hospitals, Mechi, Koshi, Inaruwa, BPKIHS, Chief of Health Office Jhapa, Morang, Sunsari and Ilam, Chief of Provincial Training Center, Health Coordinator of Itahari, Birtamod, Biratnagar, ART Counselor, Partners representatives(FHI360, BDS, Sparsha Nepal). The main objective of the event was to disseminate the information regarding the ending of "EpiC Nepal" and serve the groundwork of the new program, "USAID Sustainable HIV Epidemic Control" by aligning all stakeholders, clarifying objectives, roles and responsibilities and ensuring everyone involved has a shared understanding of the project's scope, timelines and deliverables.
