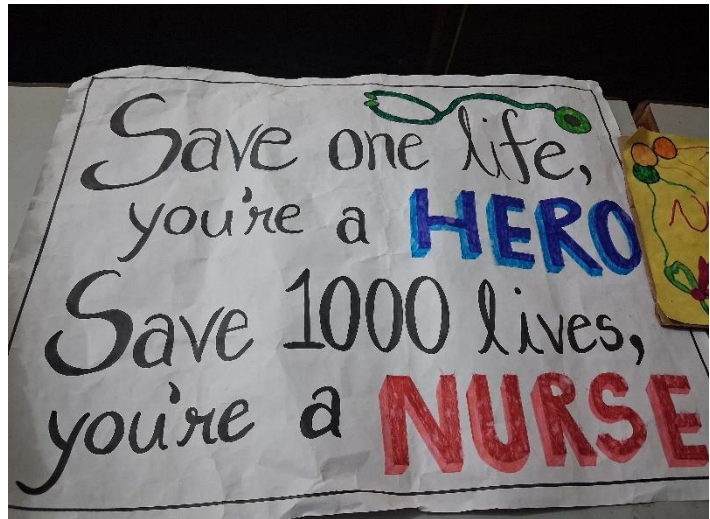

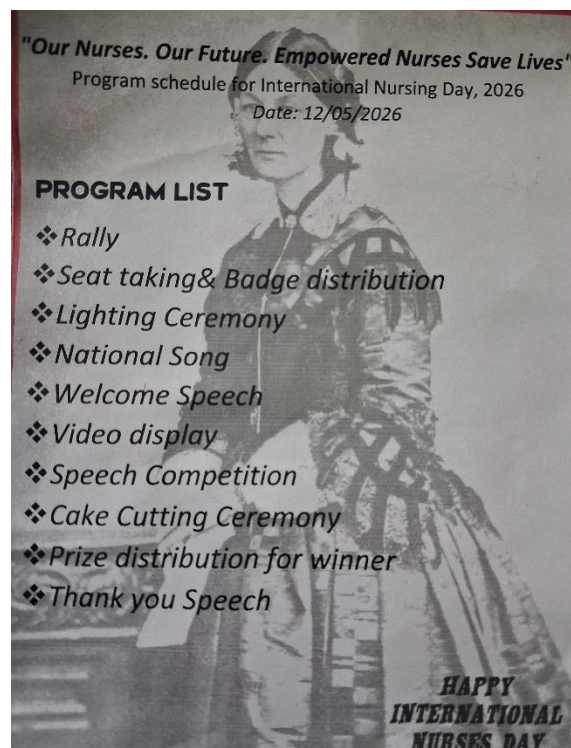
A Report on International Nurses' Day 2026, celebration

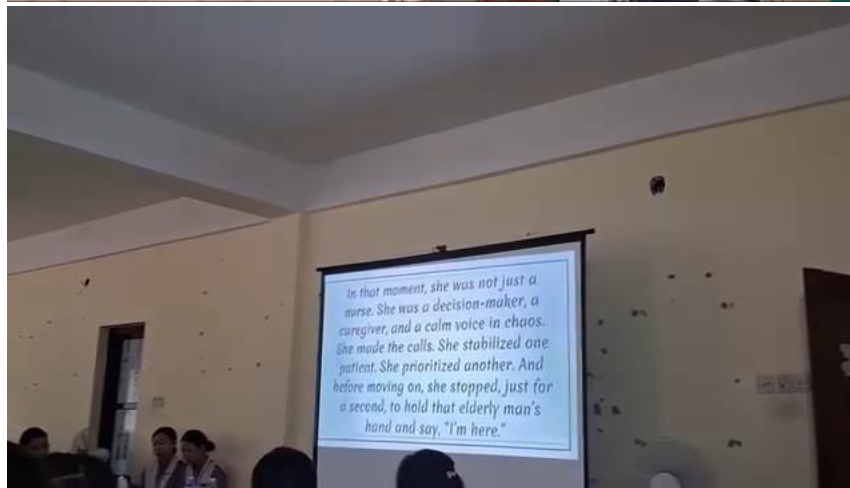
