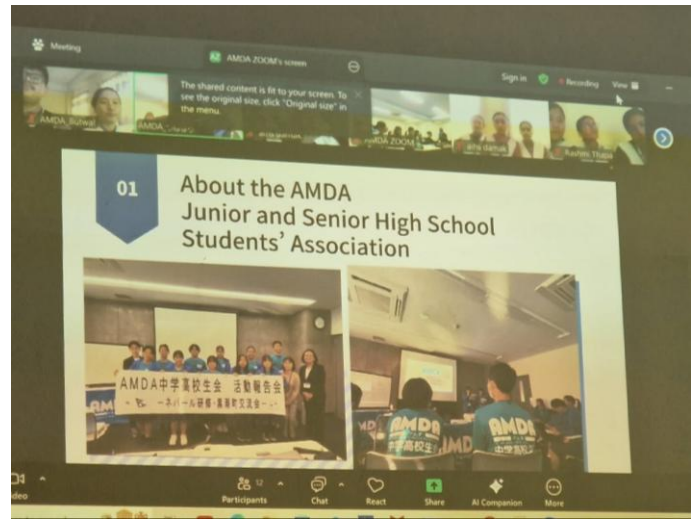
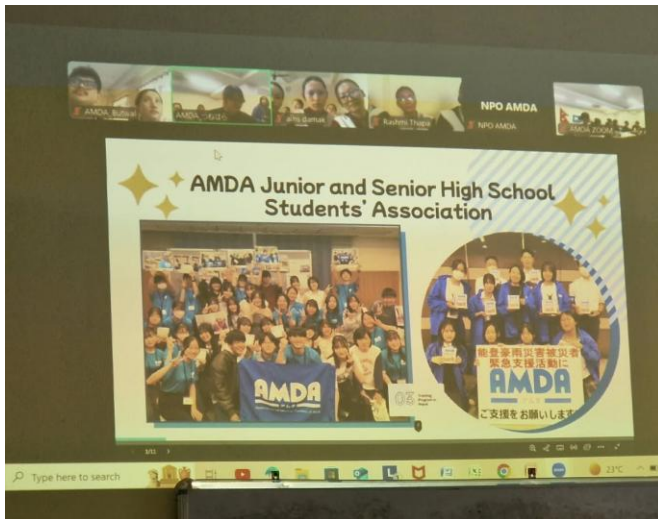

The participating students were:

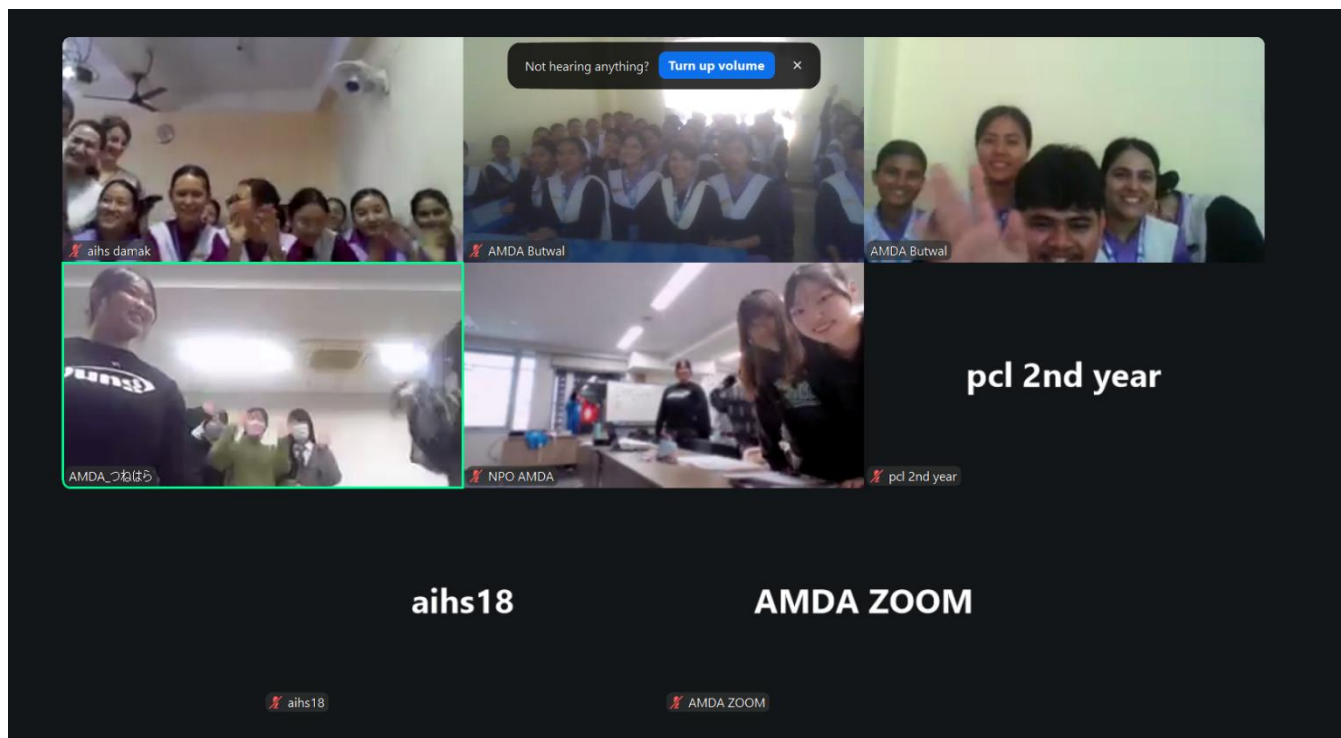
- **PCL Nursing 3rd Year:** Ms. Dina Gurung, Ms. Divyata Malla Thakuri, and Ms. Manisha Neupane
